PUP TO JOBSEEKERS TRANSITION ISSUES?

- 
- No prior experience of *'conditional'* qualification, or of engagement in, an *'Activation'* process
 - Understanding how to engage in a target driven and *'control'* orientated activation process for ongoing entitlement to payment and other supports / options.
 - *'Suitable Employment'* clause and GSW in its real world application in DSP / Activation terms – *'Work that is suitable for a person of your age, experience and qualifications**'*

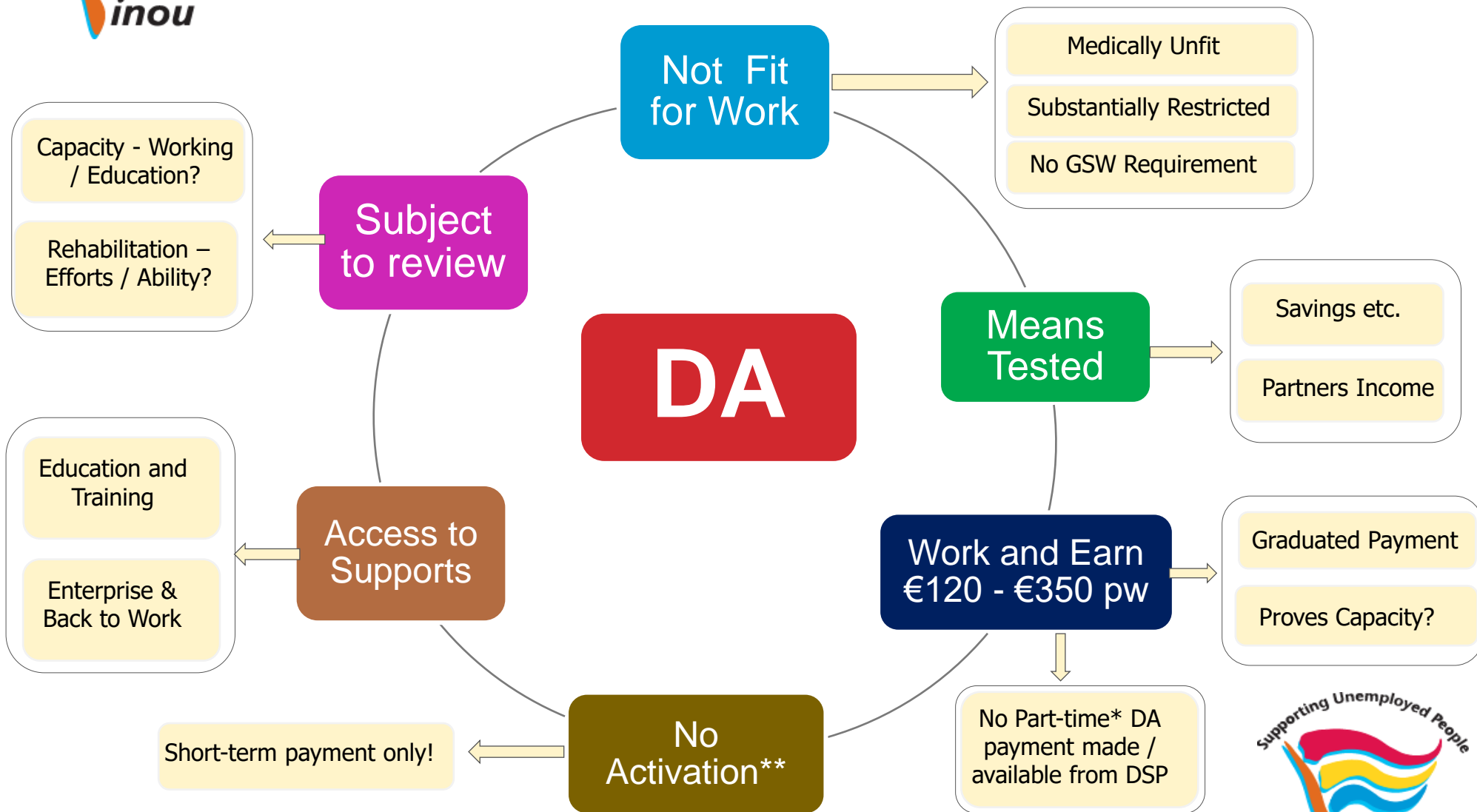

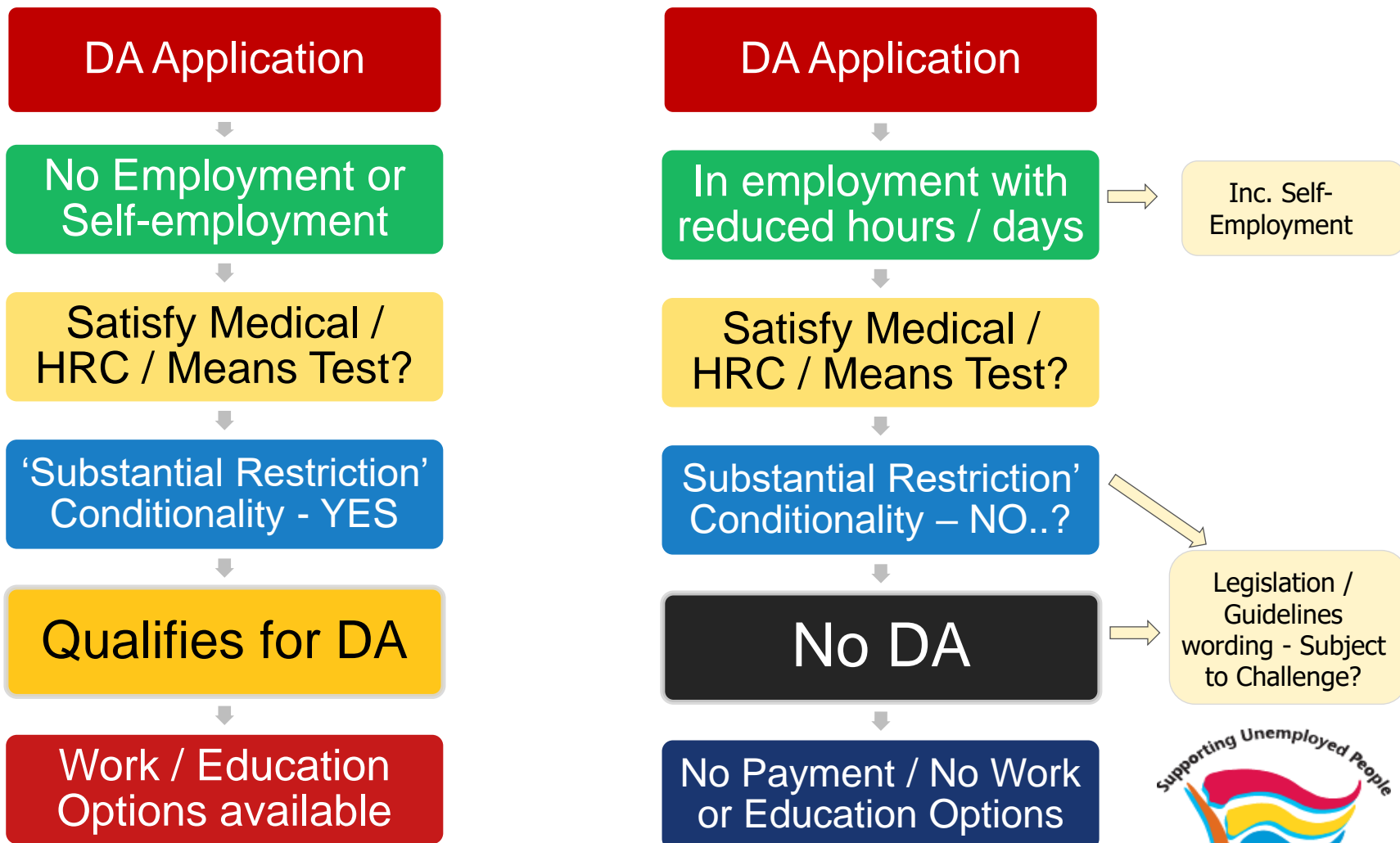
MAIN DA CONSIDERATIONS

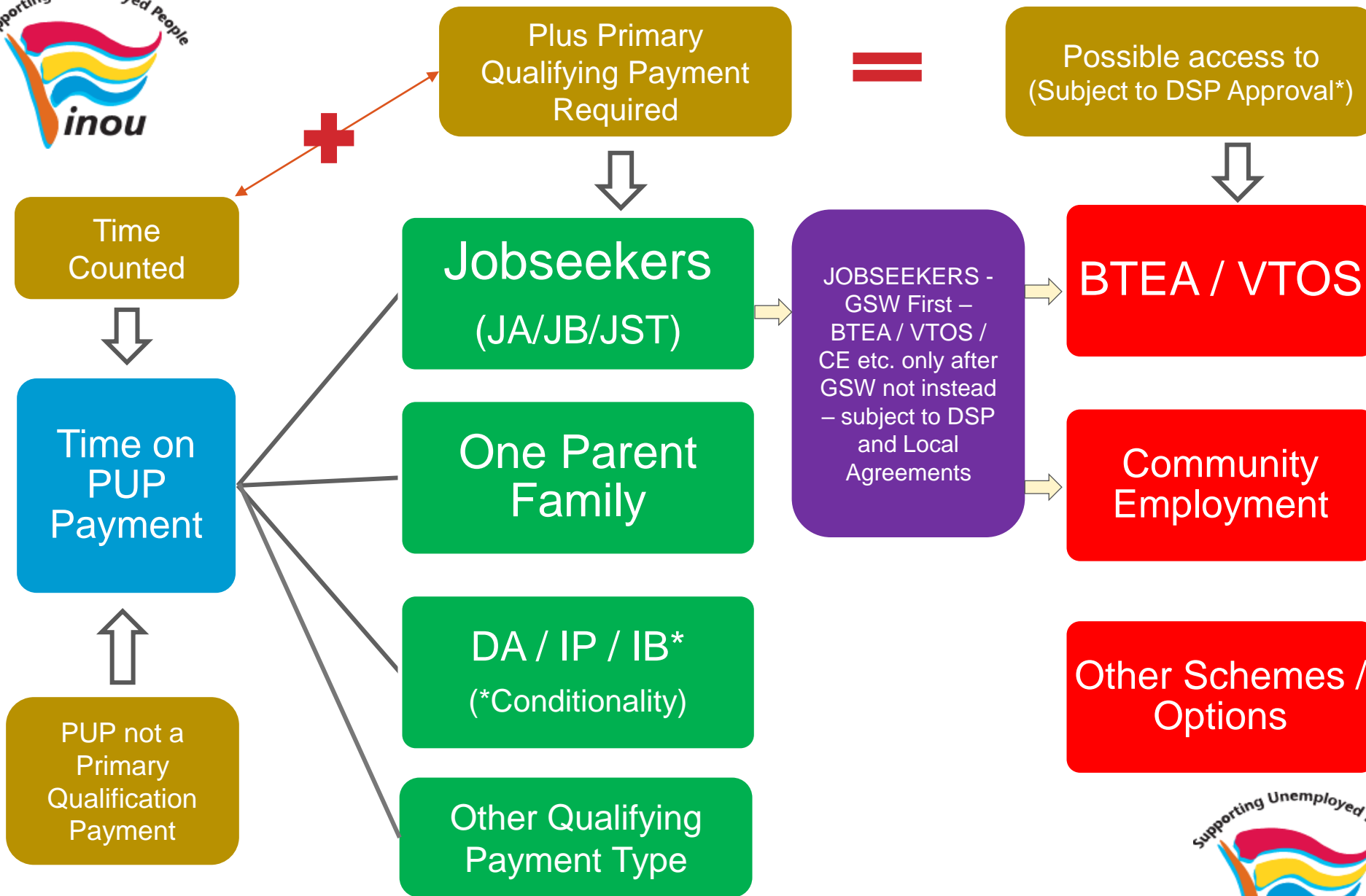
- 
- Have an injury, disease or physical or mental disability that has continued or may be expected to continue for at least one year; *and*
 - Be substantially restricted from doing work that would otherwise be suitable for a person of your age, experience and qualifications – *(Possible Issues)*
